Criteria:

- High School Senior from NC
- GPA: 3.0 or higher
- Student-athlete who has participated in two organized sports for the current school year.
- Any Sport Combination (Basketball, Football)
- Demonstrates commitment to academics and athletics.
- Enrolled in two- or four-year post-secondary education institutions

1. Review Eligibility Requirements

2. Gather Required Documents

Prepare two recommendation letters, and any essays or personal statements. Double-check that all documents are current and properly formatted.

3. Complete the Application Form

Fill out every section accurately and honestly. Incomplete or incorrect information can delay or prevent consideration.

4. Submit Before the Deadline

Pay attention to submission dates and send your application early. Late applications are typically not accepted.

5. Follow Up

After submission, confirm that your application was received. Stay available for any additional requests, such as interviews or supplemental materials.
